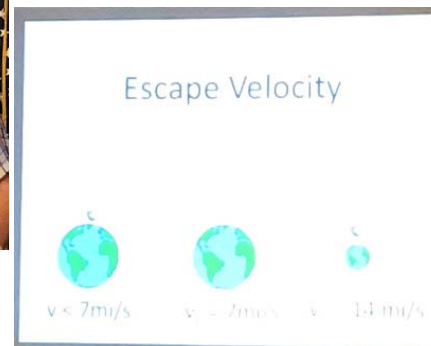

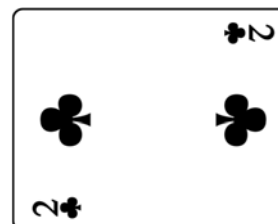

Origin of the Four-Way Test

- Created in 1932 by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor (Rotary International President 1954-55), when asked to take charge of an aluminum cookware company facing bankruptcy.
- Adopted by Rotary in 1943.
- Translated into over 100 languages and published in thousands of ways as a "simple measuring stick of ethics".
